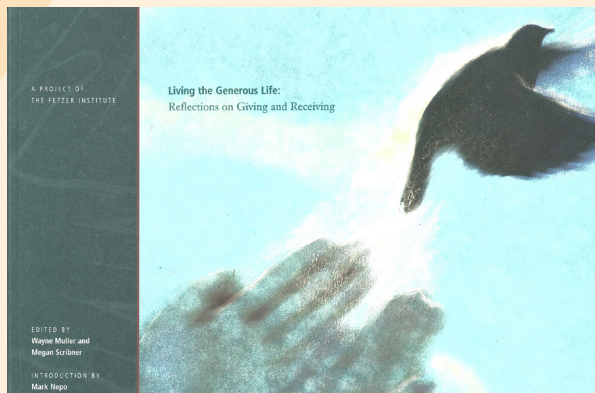


# LIVING THE GENEROUS LIFE
